Prayer for Christmas Eve

P: Lord, you taught us that all who really seek you will find the desires of the heart met in Jesus. In times of difficulty and doubt, never let us rest until we have worked our way through to abiding in Jesus.

L: Lord, they brought you gifts of gold and frankincense.

P: Lord, keep our eyes fixed on the great goal of life, to bring you the gold of our obedience and the incense of our worship and the sacrifice of our praise, for you alone are worth. Amen
